



GUEST INFORMATION

The Makusue Ski and Sport Club is a cooperative effort between members to ensure a clean, safe environment for members and guests. Please consider during your stay that no one at the club is compensated for any work that they do.

Below is a list of general guidelines and things to expect from your stay at the Makusue Ski and Sport Club:

PLANNING YOUR STAY

Make your reservation through your sponsor by 12:00 PM on the Wednesday before the weekend you arrive. When there are enough people staying at the lodge, a chef will cook meals. The cost for these meals is \$25 for two breakfasts and one dinner (Saturday).

You will need to bring bedding for a twin size bed, including pillows, blankets, and sheets or a sleeping bag. You will need to bring a towel if you plan to bathe (we hope that you do!). If you forget either of these, there is a Walmart by 302 and start of the North-South road.

ARRIVING AT THE CLUB

When you arrive, find a member that can locate the room to which you have been assigned. You will need to sign into the house as a guest. Guest fees are \$25 per night. There are set collection times, so please be prepared to pay for your lodging, meals, and invitation needs at that time. We only accept CASH.

If you plan to attend a social event, you will be given a guest pass. Please ensure that you sign the back of this card. Otherwise it is not valid. Please also purchase the appropriate number of invitations (\$12 each) from the collector when you pay for your lodging and/or meals. If you attend a social event, you must have a signed guest pass and an invitation (blue) to be admitted into the social event.

During your first visit each season, you will be asked to sign a guest release and waiver. This is to protect the club by preventing frivolous lawsuits.

DEPARTING THE CLUB

Please ensure that you leave the room you are staying in the way you found it. There is a list posted in each room to provide guidance.

After staying at the club a few times, you may be assigned a house cleaning duty to complete before leaving. This is usually a simple clean-up task for the house at the end of the weekend, and we appreciate everyone's assistance.
